In February I had the opportunity to address our presbyterate on the topic of vocations to the priesthood, and I want to take this moment to encourage each of you to do something on the upcoming World Day of Prayer for Vocations, which is Sunday, April 30. Within the archdiocese, this day is our Annual Vocations Appeal. We need to call forth vocations from our people, which is part of shepherding them.
