


Vocation Office

PRAY FOR VOCATIONS

- 1. During adoration or in your classroom, think of all the people who have found their vocation. Write their names, color the pictures and then pray for those people.
- 2. Reflect on your talents and the desires God has placed in your heart. Imagine yourself in the future being either a wife or religious sister (for girls), or a husband, priest, deacon, or religious brother (for boys). Then pray for your vocation. Pray to be open and brave to follow God's calling.
- **3.** Now write your reflection to Jesus in your journal or on a separate sheet of paper. Write to Him your thoughts, and take Him on this journey with you. Nobody will read your reflections.
